

Restriction on Product Placement and Right of Publicity

Photographer agrees that photographs will not be used in a disparaging manner.

Company hereby warrants and represents that it is the owner of Product and that the consent of no other person or company may grant Photographer use of Pictures containing Product as described herein. The agreed upon restriction shall not violate the rights of any kind of any third parties. Furthermore, Company grants permission for Photographer to furnish Pictures containing Product to _____ ("Bride and Groom").

Company may seek remedies for breach of any provision of this agreement and reserves the right to seek or be entitled to injunctive or other equitable relief by reason of any breach or threatened breach of this agreement, or for any other reason pertaining hereto. Company may also be entitled to seek to enjoin or restrain the exhibition, distribution, advertising, exploitation or marketing of Pictures containing Product.

I agree that this agreement shall be binding on me, my legal representatives, heirs, and assigns. I have read this agreement and fully familiar with its contents and terms.
